## Entry Requirements:

All learners should meet the following:

- Attend or take part in an initial assessment interview either in person or via telephone
- Hold or be willing to work towards level 2 in literacy and numeracy
- Hold relevant vocational and/or academic qualifications of at least the level above that of their learners
- Hold a current (at least 2 years old) CRB check or apply for a CRB check prior to the course commencing (this is the responsibility of your own organisation)

The cost of the course is **£175.00** per person (for those from voluntary and community organisations; this covers all costs and accreditation. Individuals from statutory organisations will pay a higher course fee – please ask for details.
